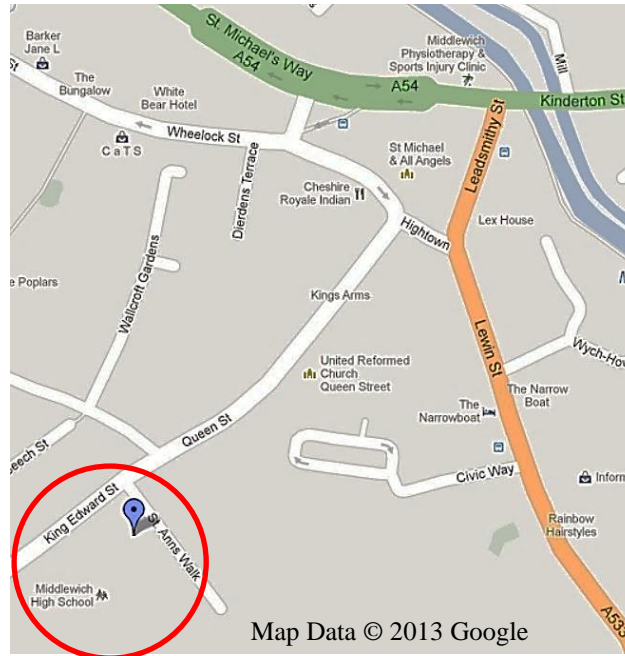

The **FREE** car park for the Drama Studio is located on St Anns Walk, opposite Oaklands Surgery (whose Post Code is CW10 9BE for Sat. Nav. users). St Anns Walk is off King Edward Street / Queen Street opposite Jack's (ex-Tesco).

The only access to the Drama Studio is through the car park. Pass through the vehicle gateway (immediately on your right as you drove, or walked, into the car park). Now cross the playground / courtyard, and the Drama Studio itself is in the far right-hand corner.

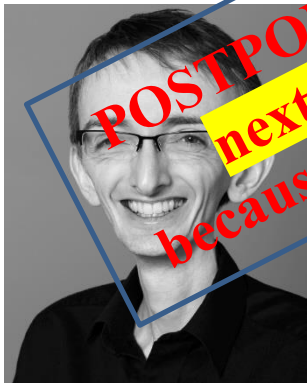
